With Crowley's price cap contract, the price listed represents the highest price you will pay per gallon of oil in the upcoming heating season. If the price comes down -- and who knows if prices will come down -- then you will pay the lower price.

Off-Road Diesel Rules Changing on October 1st.

Federal laws governing the sale of diesel fuel, effective on October 1, require all diesel fuel to be low in sulfur. Because heating oil has a higher-than-allowed sulfur content - and because we do not have the storage facilities for the low-sulfur diesel - Crowley Fuel will no longer be able to sell off-road diesel after Sept. 30.

We regret this change, but we thank current customers for your past patronage. Please do not hesitate to contact us if we may be of assistance in identifying alternative sources for this product in the future.
